Welcome & Introductions	Maggie King thanked participants for their attendance at the meeting. Due to teleconference attendees, introductions were held.	
Approval of draft minutes dated October 19, 2016	The October 19, 2016 meeting minutes were approved.	
Reports/New Business	<p>Bristol Regional Medical Center-Claudia reported it has been a slow few months, but they have seen an improvement in times to be under 45 minutes now.</p> <p>Twin County Regional Hospital-Carla reported activase was administered 14 times in 2016 with an average time of 63 minutes. Carla also reported they will be transitioning into a new teleneurology center that places a physician on-screen within 5 minutes. Carla reported the inclusion/exclusion criteria and Carla became an ASLS instructor.</p> <p>The current Stroke Triage plan was reviewed. Some formatting and font changes were suggested. Holston Valley will be added as a certified primary stroke center. Also, the need for written consent is not required if it is within 3 hours because that is part of the standard of care.
