Topic/Subject	Discussion	Recommendations, Action/Follow-up; Responsible Person
Call to Order	The meeting was called to order at 2:01 p.m.	
Welcome & Introductions	Introductions were made and Maggie Long thanked participants for their attendance at the meeting. The previous meeting minutes were approved.	
Reports	<p>Dr. Ladley reported he has been attending STEMI network lectures in Tennessee (Knoxville, Nashville, Memphis) and recently attended the Mission Lifeline annual meeting. At this meeting, there was an EMS panel and they said our area is doing really well with hospital/EMS relations. Dr. Ladley also reported they are continuing to educate individuals and EMS.</p> <p>Dr. Patterson reported that JMH has moved to quarterly STEMI meetings with EMS and they are using those as an opportunity to educate providers, review cases and review in field guidelines.</p> <p>Tammy Collins reported JMH had a STEMI conference October 16-19. The conference focused on coordination of care between EMS and the hospital. They also performed a scenario from the time of first medical contact to balloon time in the cath lab. As a result of this conference, they are looking at new protocols and ways to educate EMS as well as grants for themselves and for EMS to get the equipment they need.</p> <p>Jessica Antonino said things are going well and had nothing new to report</p>	

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	<p>Dr Turner reported MedFlight II was out of service for several weeks following the crash in Charlottesville, but with help from other flight services no calls went unanswered and there were no delays in care.</p> <p>James Hubbard reported that students in the Paramedic Program seem to be coming in to class with a better understand of STEMI protocols and they are becoming more widely known.</p>	
Unfinished Business	There was no unfinished business.	
New Business	Members discussed adding a patient info sheet into the STEMI plan for EMS to fill out. This sheet will include drugs given, patient's age, weight and other pertinent details. Leslie will send a copy of the STEMI sheet Wellmont currently uses.
